Have you considered...

... the Mosquito? They will soon be out in MN! The mosquito called *Aedes aegypti* lays her eggs just above the waterline. Her embryos can wait up to five years until conditions are just right to hatch. How is it able to do this? Because of the design of the mosquito egg. The egg has four layers with the embryo inside. The baby mosquito needs oxygen, or it will die. The outer two layers allow the oxygen to get in, even if the egg is underwater. The outer layer sheds water and acts like a gill, allowing the egg to 'breathe'. 'Breathing' is done by nano-bumps which have a special hexagonal pattern that prevents clogging allowing the oxygen in. The mosquito egg also needs to retain the correct amount of moisture. To enable this, the embryo secretes a jelly-like substance that surrounds the embryo. This substance then secretes a harder substance, chitin. All this allows the correct amount of water to stay in the egg, while removing excess. So, the egg is designed for the right amount of oxygen and the right amount of moisture. It now waits for the right conditions for hatching!

What are the right conditions for the eggs to hatch? Low levels of oxygen in the water. Low oxygen level signals an abundance of algae and bacteria so the egg hatches and has enough food to survive.

Evolutionists explain the complex design of a mosquito egg happened by time and chance. The closer we look at nature the more we see design, which ultimately points to a designer and that designer is God.



