...spiders and ants that inspired a new metal structure that is unsinkable? Scientists studied diving bell spiders that trap air bubbles underwater and rafts of fire ants that trap air to float. Curious scientists wanted to copy this. So, lasers etched two small metal aluminum plates, placed them facing each other and joined them with a plastic spacer at the precise distance to trap the air. The result, it floated. Even after being held down for two months, it immediately floated to the surface. Researchers then poked the air pocket numerous times, but it still kept the air trapped. Inquisitive scientists were just copying what had already been made. Scientists recognized a good design.

### TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF



### Annual report from the TCCSA board of directors
