

History Track - Egyptian/Hebrew History Part 2, 2019-20 School Year

From Abraham, Joseph, Moses and Jesus, a period of nearly 2000 years, the history of the Hebrews and Egyptians has been closely entwined together. There are interactions between them that affected each nation's economy, literature and individual lives. In fact, the Bible is better understood in the light of Egyptian/Hebrew Archeology.

The most fascinating and inspirational part of that history is how Moses wrote the first five books of the Bible. Genesis 5:1 Says: "This is the book of the generations of Adam." Did you know that Adam wrote a book recording the events of Genesis 1-5? Just as Luke was inspired by God to compile parts of Luke and Acts from eye witnesses he interviewed, so Moses may have used Adam's book as well as Noah's and Joseph's books to write Genesis. We will have an exhibit at the Adventure Safaris Museum to show the 2100-year history of the writing of the Bible.

L13-14 Tutankhamen and the God of Light. Did he know the one true God? (An illustrated Power Point story)

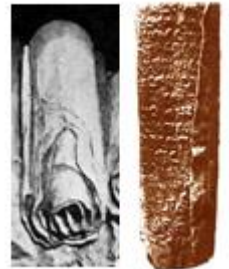
L15- Maohenjo-Daro – Life after the Flood. One of the first cities build by the sons of Shem? Gen.11:2
