ACTIVITY – Dig into History. Experience what it is like to be on an Egyptian archaeology dig. We have an area behind the museum where kids can dig up Egyptian and Hebrew artifacts and learn how the archaeologist did it in Egypt.

ACTIVITY (Optional) – Learn about Egyptian Hieroglyphics. Translate the glyphs on King Tut's Canopic box and "hope" chest to find out what were the words concerning "life after death." This activity is an option. It takes about 40 min. Many families chose to do the tour and listen to a short colorful program about "Archaeological Evidence of God's Interaction that Changed the History of Egypt."

Why was a mummy identified by modern scholars as "Unknown Man E" described as the most unusual mummy ever discovered from any period of Egyptian history?

Also highlighted will be a full sized reproduction of King Tutankhamen's Sarcophagus with an explanation on how mummification took place. King Tut was the Grandson of Amenhotep III, the Pharaoh defeated by God through Moses. Why did King Tut's father, Amenhotep IV, abolish all priests and temples and introduce worship of one God?
