It's A Young World After All Radioisotope Evidence

7:30 PM, April 17, 2007, Room 116, Totino Fine Arts Center, Northwestern College

Dr. John Baumgardner is a Geophysics Professor and Director of the ICR Scientific Corporate Center. He was an early advocate for the concept of catastrophic plate tectonics and chief developer of the TERRA program for computer modeling of the dynamics of the earth's mantle.

A number of recent findings cast grave doubts on conventional uniformitarian geology.

- Measurable Carbon 14 in coal, oil, and fossils thought to be tens to hundreds of millions of years old (and should therefore have no measurable Carbon 14).
- The residual Helium content determinations found in rocks with that exhibit radioactive decay (and should have long ago diffused out of the rocks).
- The pleochroic halos radioactivity evidence.

This presentation is designed for general audiences. However, he is very capable of fielding the technical questions. John led the project that verified the presence of Carbon 14 in coal and discovered C-14 in diamonds. **Note: we will meet in Room 116 NOT the Chapel!**

the African gazelle. Did you know that it has a radiator in its nose? When chased by a lion, the African gazelle can reach speeds up to 50 mph. This raises the body temperature. How long did it take a gazelle to come up with this radiator in its nose? Picture this: Mr. Gazelle is being chased by a lion; without the radiator, he boils his brains and dies. If he slows up (in order to not overheat), he is caught by the lion and dies. What Mr. Gazelle needed was a radiator from the beginning in order for him to survive and that is what the Master Designer gave him.
