Icons of Evolution

When asked to list the evidence for Darwinian evolution, most people--including most biologists--give the same set of examples, because all of them learned biology from the same few textbooks. The most common examples:

*chemical building-blocks of living cells created in a flask; *the evolutionary tree of life; *similar bone structures in many creatures; *drawings of similarities in embryos; *archaeopteryx; *peppered moths; *Darwin's finches on the Galapagos Islands; *fruit flies with genetic mutations; *a branching-tree pattern of horse fossils; and *drawings of ape-like creatures evolving into humans, showing that we are just animals and that our existence is merely a by-product of purposeless natural causes.

These examples are so frequently used as evidence for Darwin's theory that most of them have been called "icons" of evolution. Yet all of them, in one way or another, misrepresent the truth.

This video is based on the book by Jonathan Wells. Using video, animation and personal interviews with scientists, this program will show you some of the fallacies of evolution. Copies of this and other DVD's and books will be available for purchase at the meeting. Bring the whole family.

.... on a hot, summer day how one large tree can pump over 1,000 gallons of water from its roots to its leaves. How is this possible? The hot sun causes water to evaporate from the leaves. Because water likes to "stick together," this pulls the water up the tree like a drinking straw. This water can move up to 25 miles per hour. Ninety percent of the water is transpired in this way, while only 2% is used for photosynthesis. Literally tons of water are taken from the soil and released into the air each day. This is an amazing system involving capillary flow, osmosis and vacuum pressure. All this happens in total silence! This truly is an example of God's engineering excellence!



TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
