Feathered Dinosaurs —Fact or Fiction?

7:30 PM, September 16, 2008, Totino Fine Arts Center, F2128 (Old Room 116), Northwestern College

Those fascinating dinosaurs! The media make pronouncements that are accepted by the public as revealed truth, not knowing all the behind-the-scenes uncertainty. Often a scientist makes a cautious, nuanced pronouncement, suitable for a refereed journal that will be read by specialists who know the limitations of the findings. An awestruck reporter turns it into a "story" worthy of headlines. The most publicized recent feathered dinosaur was Archaeoraptor. An artist's reconstruction was featured on the cover of National Geographic with pictures of the slab containing the fossil inside the issue. When the counter slab was located showing that feathers had been added, proving it to be a fraud, National Geographic published an obscure retraction, hidden in the back of an issue, stating that the fossil was "a composite."

Beside this, the findings of blood cells and elastic tissue, unfossilized, in T Rex bone marrow, shows clearly that dinosaurs were around thousands of years ago and could not have been extinct for 65 million years.

It seems that all dinosaur reconstructions now feature feathers. How strong is the case? If you already believe that dinosaurs evolved into birds, then every frayed collagen fiber and every feather, that might actually be a true bird feather buried near a dinosaur, will be accepted as confirmation. ...the koala. The koala feeds on eucalyptus leaves which are poisonous. Yet the koalas make their homes in these very eucalyptus trees, eating the poisonous leaves for nourishment and water. How does the koala survive? It all takes place within the digestive system. Koalas, like many other mammals, cannot digest the cellulose in the leaves; therefore, it depends on microorganisms within the intestines to digest them. The place where the small and large intestine converge is the caecum. The caecum functions as a fermentation chamber where microbes digest cellulose, while at the same time, neutralizes the poison. Why would these poisonneutralizing microbes exist there if the koalas were not eating these leaves? And if the koala had these microbes, which koala would volunteer first to eat these leaves when other creatures die from ingesting these leaves? This caecum with the neutralizing microbes did not happen by chance. God designed it. Isn't it wonderful to see God's fingerprint in nature.


