Joe Taylor is a one-of-a-kind kind of guy starting as a farm kid in West Texas. He has a degree in Advertising Design and Illustration using his talent designing everything from type fonts, book and album covers to billboards. He also played with several bands in churches and Christian coffee houses from coast to coast. Joe learned to dig and preserve fossils on a ranch near his hometown of Crosbyton, TX.

In 1976 Joe heard Dr. Duane Gish in a debate with an evolutionist and it changed his artistic focus. Creationists had the right message but didn't have the fossils to back them up. In the early 1980's he worked at the La Brea Tar Pits restoring fossils. His skill convinced rabid atheists to help him become a paleontologist without going back to school. His ability to restore, sculpt and mold opened many basement collections in major institutions and private collections. It also gave him real knowledge about fossils and their living counterparts.

In addition to his own museum in Crosbyton, he has helped AiG with their new museum and taught others some of his skills. Joe has authored several books and is working on more.
