Origins of Man

7:30 PM, September 15, 2009, Totino Fine Arts Center, Room F2128 (Old F116), Northwestern College

This talk takes a look at the origins of man and a look at evolutionary lack of evidence. Subjects include: we all look at the evidence in different ways (same evidence -- different bias), human evolution chart, Neanderthal man, Ramapithecus, Java man, Australopithecus (Lucy), Laetoli ash fields, Piltdown man, and Nebraska man. A goal here is to teach children to recognize artwork and to ask the question, "What's the Evidence?" The evidence does not point to evolution, but to Biblical Creation as the better answer! May include a short talk about how old the earth is and problems with the dating methods used today.

Lanny and Marilyn Johnson are former evolutionists trained in the sciences. Creation teaching was instrumental in bringing them to a settled assurance that all of God's Word can be trusted. In 1993, God led them to join Alpha Omega Institute and establish the Children's Ministry to fortify children with the truth of the Bible and to help them avoid the pitfalls of evolution. The whole family will enjoy this one.

Have you considered...

bird breath. Birds do not breathe in and out like we do, but have a different breathing system. Bird lungs are rigid and act like filters. Air flows through the lungs to air sacs, which are sandwiched between muscles and limbs, and act as bellows to move the air. Breathing is a little complicated, but basically birds breathe in and out at the same time. Oxygen is rapidly absorbed as it flows against huge numbers of tiny blood vessels in the lungs. Maximum oxygen is obtained and maximum carbon dioxide is quickly removed. Because of this design, birds can fly vigorously for great distances without tiring. The blackpoll warblers migrate non-stop for 85 hours as it flies to South America. Hummingbirds migrating from Minnesota meet their greatest challenge when they cross the Gulf of Mexico. They fly 600 miles non-stop across the Gulf waters to reach South America. They do this in 18 hours. And, we think it's great to run a 26 mile marathon. God has designed an amazing way for birds to breathe, so they can be flying machines.

A look at fascinating Fibonacci numbers and the Divine Proportion are just one more example of the endless incredible design found everywhere in nature -- design that could never happen by the chance and accident of evolution. The evidence is clear that it is "God that made the world and all things therein," (Acts 17:24a). Only the hand of God could create such marvelous wonders that we find around us!

Fibonacci numbers and the Fibonacci sequence are prime examples of "how mathematics is connected to seemingly unrelated things." Even though these numbers were introduced in 1202 in Fibonacci's book *Liber abaci*, they remain fascinating and mysterious to people today.

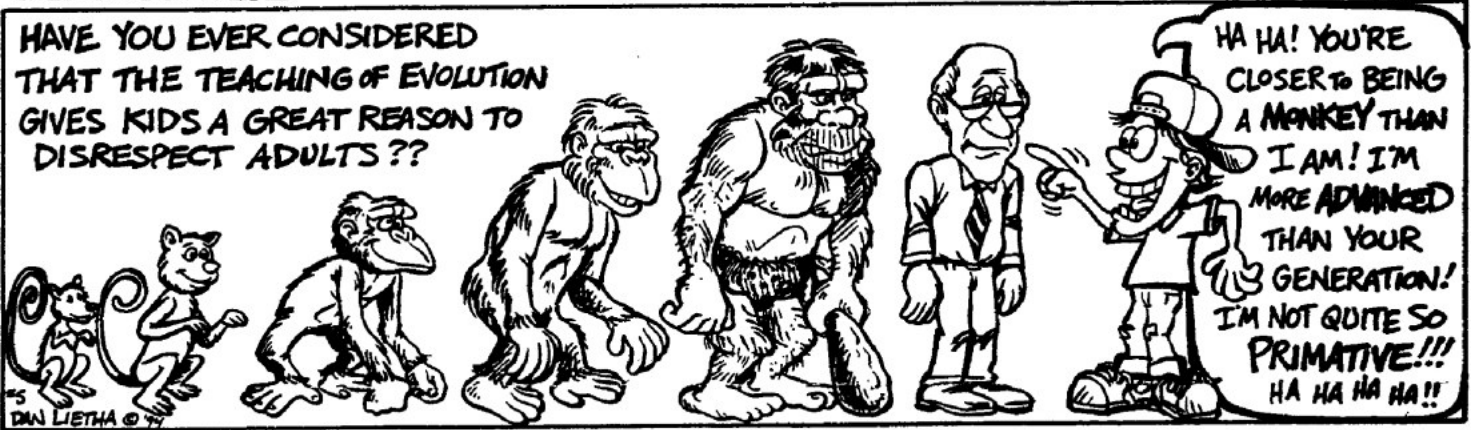

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
