Charles Babbage: The Inventor of the Calculating Machine

7:30 PM, September 18, 2012, Totino Fine Arts Center, Room F2128, Northwestern College, Roseville

The Analytical Engine was the first fully-automatic calculating machine. British computing pioneer Charles Babbage (1791-1871) first conceived the idea of an advanced machine to calculate and print mathematical tables in 1812. He had a host of other inventions that will be discussed. He wrote the Bridgewater Treatises of 1837 in defense of the Gospel.

He and Ada Byron, worked out the punch card system for loading information into the computer. Electronic computers still use his basic math system for their input. His Analytical Engine was the size of a Volkswagen Bus and was all mechanical.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
