



The Age of the Universe

A straightforward reading of Scripture clearly teaches six-day creation with an age of thousands of years. Does science teach billions of years? Don't billions of light-years require billions of years to travel? What is light anyway? How did conventional science arrive at the Big Bang? What assumptions were made along the way? What would happen if we rethought some fundamental notions in physics? Do Creationists offer alternatives? Do they agree with each other? Can the Genesis account of creation actually offer insight into fundamental physics? This presentation delves into all of these questions and offers real answers to some very tough questions. It will confirm that Scripture is trustworthy, God is in control, and His creation is even more awesome than we've ever imagined.

He is also co-founder and editor of the World Science Database, a web-based resource cataloging the work of several thousand independent scientists worldwide.

Have you considered...

...evidence for the Genesis Flood. One such evidence is the world-wide phenomena of folded rocks. Geologists find entire strata sequences folded without fracturing. This is only possible when the sedimentary layers are still soft and pliable like modeling clay, when they were folded. In the same manner, if modeling clay dries out it becomes hard and brittle, unable to bend without breaking or shattering. Many of these folded rock sequences show no sign of breaking or shattering.

When geologists examine many of these folded rocks, they find no evidence of high temperature; these rocks were bent at normal temperatures. These folded sedimentary rocks were still sedimentary rocks! This can only mean that these folded rocks were still soft and pliable when folded. During the Genesis Flood there would have been rapid movements of the plates on the Earth's crust. No sooner would the floodwater have laid down great quantities of sand and mud than moving plates would have crumpled the sediment while still pliable, resulting in folded rocks. The Genesis flood would have been a powerfully destructive event leaving evidence of folded rock strata around the world.
