The Genetics of Adam and Eve

One of the Biggest debates in evangelical Christianity today is whether or not Adam and Eve were real people. Sadly many Christian theologians and scientists believe that genetics has disproven the existence of an original couple specially created by God. In addition to accommodate a non-literal Adam and Eve, many have begun to redefine sin and salvation. In this presentation we will explore both the theological importance of Adam and Eve to the gospel and how the science of genetics supports and is consistent with the fact that all humans have descended from an original couple created by God as described in Genesis.

Dr. Georgia Purdom earned her doctorate from Ohio State University in molecular genetics and spent six years as a professor of biology at Mt. Vernon Nazarene University. She is now a researcher and writer for Answers in Genesis-US, and she teaches online courses for Answers Education Online.

Does this mean that there was a walking talking snake? If it were true we would expect people to remember some of the details and carry that memory with them when they left the Tower of Babel. We find such details in a 13 foot bronze fruit tree that was excavated in 1986 near Guangham, China (dated 2,700 to 4,700 years ago by secular dating). Attached to this 13 foot bronze fruit tree was a human hand and a snake with feet. Genesis 3:6, records that Eve took fruit from the forbidden tree and ate. Genesis 3 continues with the snake being cursed by God and now "on your belly shall you go and dust shall you eat all the days of your life. (Gen. 3:14)." This implies that previously the snake had legs and walked. The temptation of Eve was a real event in history and the Chinese recorded it in one of their artifacts.



TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths.

We believe that the great flood described in Genesis, commonly referred to as the Noachian Flood, was an historic event, world-wide in extent and effect.

We accept the account of the special creation of Adam and Eve as the first man and woman. Their subsequent fall into sin, by disobedience of God's direct command, is the basis for our belief in the necessity of a Savior for all mankind.

Therefore, we believe that Jesus Christ is our Lord and only Savior and that personal faith in Him is necessary for salvation.
