You'll marvel at a hummingbird's unique skeletal, muscular, and metabolic systems all vital to its spectacular aerial acrobatics; the endurance and navigational abilities of an Arctic tern as it travels from pole to pole during the longest migration on the planet; the instinctive strategies that enable a flock of 300,000 European starlings to evade predators at break-neck speeds; the elaborate network of a million component parts that make a single feather an aerodynamic masterpiece, and much more.

The poet William Blake wrote that to see an eagle in the air is to observe a portion of genius. In FLIGHT the ingenuity of a bird's behavior and biology showcase unmistakable evidence for design, purpose, and plan. It is evidence best explained by an intelligence that transcends the natural world.

Have you considered...

...scientists recently uncovered five octopus fossils. Octopuses are soft bodied animals and remarkably each octopus had eight of its arms fossilized with traces of muscles and rows of suckers. Some even had internal gills and ink fossilized! Today when an octopus dies it does not exist for very long, it decomposes into a slimy blob and within days, scavengers and bacteria cause it to disappear. For an octopus to fossilize would take very special conditions: fast, deep coverage with no oxygen. These special conditions would have been met in the Flood of Noah's day.

Furthermore, these five octopuses were enclosed in limestone. Limestone is considered by evolutionists to take long periods of time to form. During the Flood of Noah's time conditions would have been right for rapid limestone formation. Fossils continue to give evidence that the Flood of Noah's day did occur.




TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths.

We believe that the origin of matter and all basic types of living things, including man, came about through direct creative acts of God during the six-day creation week described in Genesis.
