Lise Meitner: The Woman Who Unleashed the Power of the Atom

Lise Meitner, with her nephew, physicist Otto Frisch, discovered and wrote the formula for unleashing the power of atomic energy. In 1891 Austria, it was illegal for a woman to go to high school or on to college. When laws were passed so she could attend college, she was homeschooled by her parents and tutors for two years in order to pass the college entrance exams.

In 1905 at age 24 she became the second woman in Europe to receive a doctorate in Physics. Madam Curie was first with a Physics doctorate in 1903 at the University of Paris.

Russ McGlenn will present the story of this amazing lady, including her escape from Nazi Germany, why someone else took credit for her work, why it took 40 years to receive credit for her work and why she became a Christian. Russ is always interesting and his well-researched topics are inspirational and educational. Kids are encouraged to bring an invention they made or a picture of one.

Have you considered...

...the North African desert scorpion; it is continually exposed to sandstorms. These same sandstorms can sandblast paint from steel, pit window glass and erode wood. So why is the scorpion's exoskeleton able to withstand such abuse? Curious scientists discovered that the scorpion exoskeleton was covered with tiny domes only 10 microns high. When computer simulation was applied it was found that these domes deflect the airflow, reducing the sandblasting erosional rate by 50% as compared to a smooth surface. Today's scientists are trying to apply this bumpy technology to turbine blades and helicopter rotors in order to reduce the sandblasting effect. These scientists are just copying what God has designed. When we see design we know there must be a designer and He is God.



TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
