Patterns of Evidence: The Exodus -- With Clips from the Movie

For more than 50 years, the vast majority of the world's most prominent archaeologists and historians have proclaimed that there is no hard evidence to support the Exodus account found in the Bible. In fact, they say that the archaeological record is completely opposed to the Bible's account. This view of extreme skepticism has spread from academia to the world. The case against the Exodus appears to be so strong that even some religious leaders are now labeling this ancient account as historical fiction.

Filmmaker Timothy Mahoney begins with the question, "Is the Bible just a myth, or did the archaeologists get it wrong?" He decided to tackle this issue with a deliberate scientific approach. After examining the details in the biblical text, he journeyed across the globe to search for patterns of evidence firsthand. The result is the most in-depth archaeological investigation into the Exodus from Egypt ever captured on film. The startling finds may change traditional views of how the Bible relates to ancient history.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

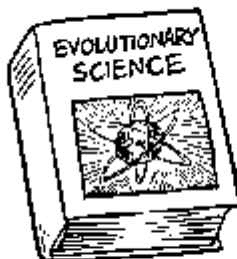

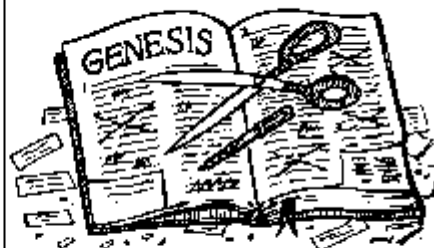
