...Termites? Termites are famous for eating wood, especially in your house. Yet termites can not digest wood. It's the microbes in the gut of the termite that break down the wood which allow it to be digested. The termites can not exist without the gut microbes and the gut microbes can not exist without the termites. Both need each other to survive. Science calls this symbiosis or mutualism, both benefiting each other in order to survive. Some scientists say this relationship evolved by accident and chance. Why would termites begin to eat wood if it could not digest it? Why would gut microbes make their home in termite guts if they were not getting the food they needed? Both termites and gut microbes had to be together from the beginning mutually depending on each other. Who would have thought that termites and their gut microbes give glory to God!

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
