



Steve Law - Patterns of Evidence: The Exodus Part 2

For more than 50 years, the vast majority of the world's most prominent archaeologists and historians have proclaimed that there is no hard evidence to support the Exodus story found in the Bible. In fact, they say that the archaeological record is completely opposed to the Bible's account. This view of extreme skepticism has spread from academia to the world. The case against the Exodus appears so strong that even some religious leaders are now labeling this ancient account as historical fiction.

Filmmaker Timothy Mahoney and researcher Steve Law begin with the question, "Is the Bible just a myth, or did archaeologists get it wrong?" They tackle this issue from a scientific approach. Starting with the Bible text and travel to the mid-east they search for evidence firsthand. The result is the most in-depth archaeological investigation into the Exodus from Egypt ever captured on film. The startling finds should change traditional views of how the Bible relates to ancient history. Steve Law tells and shows us what they found. Have you considered...

...the pterosaur cross? Did you know that pterosaurs are mentioned in the Bible, but they are called "fiery flying serpents" (Isaiah 14:29, 30:6). And in Numbers 21 as the Israelites wandered in the wilderness, they encountered "fiery serpents" (21:6, 8). Some modern commentators suggest these were venomous snakes. However the Hebrew words used to describe them include the verb which means to fly or flutter, "flying serpent". These creatures most likely were pterosaurs with venomous bites and brilliant scales that appeared "fiery". Notice in Numbers 21:9 and John 3 this creature was put on a pole. But neither the Old nor New Testaments in their original language use the word "snake" to describe what is being put on the pole. The poisonous reptiles that attacked and killed many the Israelites flew. Today's translations have the creature as snakes, it would be hard pressed to see how the people could not escape from slithering snakes, but flying serpents would be another matter. Also, in scripture a snake from Genesis to Revelation has been a symbol of Satan. A much better explanation would be a now extinct pterosaur with its wings spread on top of the pole forming a cross. What Moses may have made was a pterosaur.




