Have you considered...

...How did animals migrate around the world so quickly after the Flood of Noah's day? Remember all nostril-breathing land-dwelling animals that were not on the Ark, died. The Ark landed in the mountains of Ararat which is near present day Turkey. So how did kangaroos get to Australia and raccoons to North America? There could be several ways for the animals to migrate across the planet...

After the Flood was the one and only Ice Age caused the lowering of the sea some 300 feet (evaporated waters came onto land, fell as snow and staid for hundreds of years). This resulted in land bridges like the Bering Strait becoming a land bridge across Siberia to Alaska. The Indonesian Islands could easily have become a land bridge to Australia. Kangaroos could have hopped to Australia

Animals could have been on floating log mats with the ocean currents transporting them around the earth. In 1992 a container ship in the North Pacific lost its cargo of thousands of bathtub rubber ducks. Within three months, rubber duckies had floated to Indonesia, Australia, and South America, later they floated into the Arctic and Atlantic Oceans.

When we put on our Biblical glasses it is not difficult to see how the animals spread out and filled the land after the Flood of Noah's day.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
