## Bruce Malone: Blind to the Obvious

God has made the fact that He is our creator obvious through the written inspiration of the Bible, observation, logic, and understanding the most basic laws of science. Yet an increasing proportion of our population seem completely blind to this evidence. How did we get to this point and what do we do about the increasing blindness. This presentation explores one poignant example from each of the three major branches of science (cosmology, biology, geology) which reveals how obvious God has made the truth; then explores the three major reasons why academia, and the population at large, has become increasingly blinded to the truth.

Bruce Malone is a popular speaker for young and old who won't disappoint you with this talk. He will be bringing new resources that you will want to have.

Have you considered...

...pain can be your friend? What would life be like without pain? We have seen this in people with leprosy. Leprosy is not a skin disease but a bacterium that attacks the nervous system. Leprosy bacillus destroys nerve ending that carry pain signals so that people cannot feel anything including pain. When this happens they can easily injure themselves. People with leprosy can pick up a cup of boiling water without flinching. Many leprosy patients have had their fingers eaten by rats in their sleep and not know it. Pain tells us something is wrong. It tells you when to slow down or when we have done too much. Nothing sends us to the doctor faster than an intense pain. If we never felt pain, we would rarely know something is wrong. Pain protects us. Dr. Brand who worked with people with leprosy declared, "I cannot think of a greater gift that I could give my leprosy patients than pain."

#### **TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF**

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths. We believe that the origin of matter and all basic types of living things, including man, came about through direct creative acts of God during the six-day creation week described in Genesis. Whatever biological changes have occurred since the creation week have accomplished only changes within the created kinds. We believe that the great flood described in Genesis, commonly referred to as the Noachian Flood, was an historic event, world-wide in extent and effect. Their subsequent fall into sin, by disobedience of God's direct command, is the basis for our belief in the necessity of a Savior for all mankind. Therefore, we believe that Jesus Christ is our Lord and only Savior and that personal faith in Him is necessary for salvation.
