Have you considered the cardinal fish that lives in the reefs of tropical oceans? TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

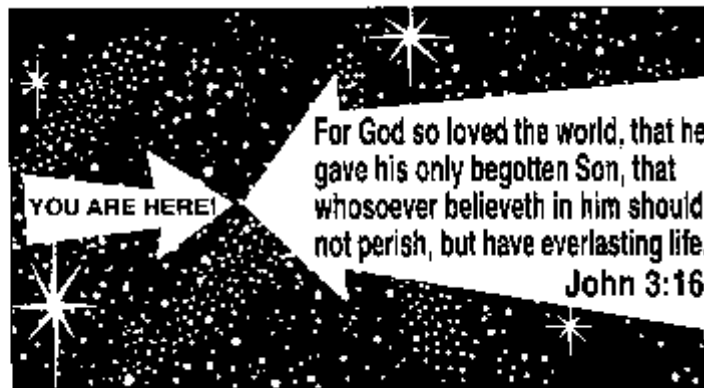
