Have you considered ...

...How do trees survive a bone chilling winter? Trees are half water, and, in the winter, water expands and freezes. What keeps the tree from bursting like frozen water pipes? Scientists have discovered two important ways trees keep their living cells living. First as the autumn cooling process sets in, the living cells of a tree become more pliable allowing most the water in the cells to move into the spaces between the cells. Secondly, removing of water from within the cell concentrates the sugars inside creating an antifreeze lowering the freezing point. The extra-cellular water is not sweetened and does freeze; however, the ice crystals do not puncture the pliable cell membranes. How does evolution explain how this came about? If it did not work the first time, we would have trees all over the forest with frozen water pipes. If the living cells freeze, they die. TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
