Have You Considered...

...Gecko self-cleaning skin? Did you know geckos can launch water off their skin like popcorn popping? Tiny nano-hair like structures cover their bodies which helps the water droplets coalesce. When the water droplets are large enough they are hurled off the skin away from the body. Any dirt that is present is rolled into the water droplet and flung with it. The coalescing of water droplets and the launching off the skin happen so quickly that a gecko is called "super-hydrophobic". Scientists in the field of biomimicry are working to design this self-cleaning, water-repelling property into fabric for clothing. These scientists recognize a great design when they see it. If there is a design, there must be a designer and that designer is God.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. 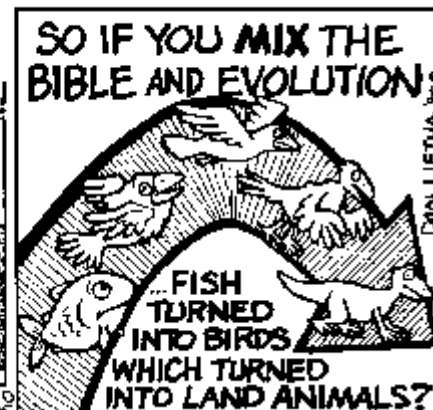
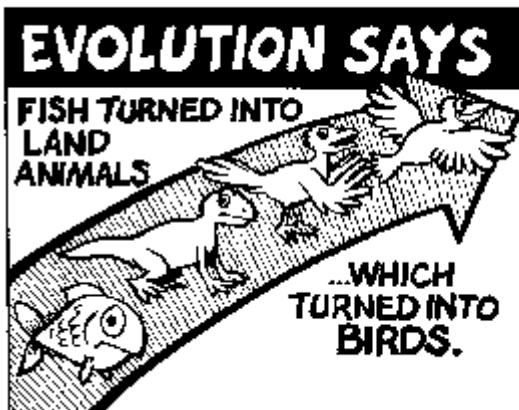
