Have You Considered ...

... Sleep is good for the brain? Recently it was scientifically discovered that sleeping rejuvenated the brain, but of course, your mother always said, "Get a good night's sleep" and she was right. Our brains use about 20 % of our energy even though it makes up only 2% of our body weight. With all that energy use, there must be a waste product. So how is the waste cleaned out? The rest of our body uses the lymphatic system to remove waste, but our brains do not contain lymph. Our brains and spinal column contain cerebrospinal fluid (CSF). When we sleep the cerebrospinal fluid flows through the brain removing the waste, even the plaques associated with Alzheimer's disease! TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
