Scientific Evidence for the Inspiration of the Bible

Have You Considered ...

... Saturn's rings. Seen through a telescope these rings appear solid. Yet with more high-tech telescopes thousands of rings closely set together are revealed. Each ring is composed of billions of particles of dust, rocks, and ice. They can range in size from a grain of sand to a house. Each ring orbits at its own rate. The rings are very thin and flat, ranging from 32 feet thick (10 meters), up to .6 miles (1 kilometer). The only reason we can see the rings from Earth is because the planet is tilted. One of the rings even looks braided! The rings and gaps are so distinct that they are even given names. Evolutionists believe the rings developed billions of years ago when objects like an asteroids, comets or moons crashed and left its debris circling. When Cassini a spacecraft went to Saturn it measured the rings gravitation pull and found it was too light for the rings to have lasted billions of years. Also, spacecraft Cassini revealed that the icy rings were too clean to be billions of years old. Astronomers are recognizing that the age of the rings are young. How old is the Universe? When we do the math of the genealogies in the bible, we find the universe is some 6,000 years old. Does Saturn's rings give evidence of a young universe, yes!

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF


