Would you like the Neck or the Wing?

Tuesday September 15, 2020, This is a live Zoom meeting, a recording will be on YouTube later.

Would you like the Neck or the Wing? In this program you get both. Russ McGlenn will be comparing the anatomy of the 40-foot-long neck of the Apatosaurus to the 7-foot-long neck of the giraffe. Russ will also compare the wings and blood circulatory system of the pterodactyl to that of a bat. He will show similar structures and how they function in the biggest pterodactyl which had a 40-foot wingspan. You can see a full-size replica of this one at the Saint Paul science museum hanging from the ceiling. So, you get a choice of a 40-foot neck or a 20-foot wing. Russ planned to be here but due to circumstances beyond our control we will see and hear him and his presentation via Zoom. The meeting will be recorded and put on YouTube.

Have You Considered ...

... where germs come from? Prior to Louis Pasteur, medical science thought germs, thus diseases, arose spontaneously. Pasteur with his ingenious swan-neck flask experiment demonstrated irrefutably that the simplest of living things cannot arise spontaneously from non-living matter. As Pasteur wrote, "Never will the doctrine of spontaneous generation recover from the mortal blow of this simple experiment!" Pasteur destroyed the evolutionary myth that the first life arose from non-living matter. Pasteur's experiment established the germ concept of disease. This scientific fact, that life comes from life, has changed how physicians combat disease-producing organisms. From the Middle Ages to Pasteur (1859) diseases were thought to arise spontaneously. Today we know that diseases come from germs that reproduce after their kind. This idea, that life comes from life and not spontaneous generation (non-life producing life), resulted in the spectacular saving of millions of lives then and now. Preventive medicine becomes possible with this truth alone. The ancient evolutionary doctrine of spontaneous generation must be discarded to do good science. Today, preventative medicine knows life come from previous life, this idea will stop the spread of diseases.

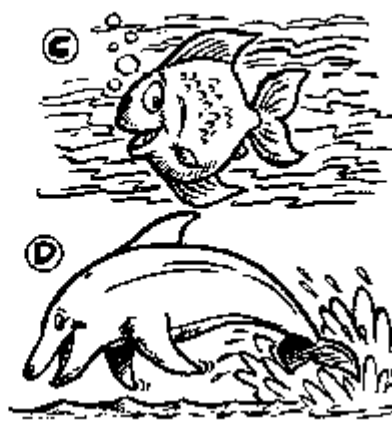
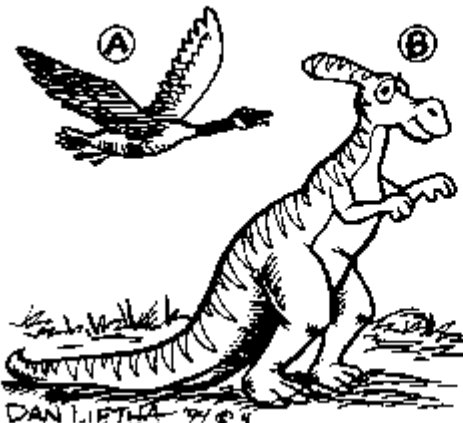
