## THANK YOU! The 3-year Fiji project to visit every secondary school in the nation has been completed!

Three years ago, God gave us an impossible task, to go to every secondary school in the nation of Fiji and give each student a creation science devotional called *Pearls in Paradise* (in the USA it is called *Have you* Considered). There were the costs, the manpower, the access to the schools, etc. God was faithful and went before us! For the past 3 years, creation science teams came together twice a year. The result, 165 secondary schools were visited, given a creation science presentation, and each student/teacher/principal was given a Pearls in Paradise book. Almost 65,000 books were given away (the remaining books have been shipped to Vanuatu and the Cook Islands)!

In March 2020 the Covid pandemic closed Fiji down. This would have been the last part of the project. It looked hopeless; however, God completed the project through those already in Fiji. One missionary and several Fijians spent this Fall going to very remote and difficult to get to island schools. Each of these remote islands had but one school and low numbers but each soul is important to our God. One boat trip was particularly adventuresome. The seas were rough, and the boat turned this way and that, the theme song from Gillian's Island kept going through the missionary's head. They should have arrived at morning light but arrived at 5 pm. Even so, the school assembled at 7 pm for the presentation.

On another island, just the day before, one of the students had asked his mother if he had evolved from an ape. How timely God is!

The 3-year project visited every secondary school in Fiji – 165 schools on 16 islands and spoke to almost 65,000 students with each student receiving the creation science devotional book, Pearls in Paradise.

Seven percent (7%) of the nation heard the presentation and was given a *Pearls* book. Each student has a mother, a father and siblings, conceivably that means more than half the population of Fiji could be influenced by this book and the Gospel message it contains. Many stories have been heard of others who have been influenced by the books, neighbors, friends, government and military personel received or have access to the books. This will literally influence an entire nation and region of the world!

#### TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths. 
