Valuable and Vicious Viruses

Tuesday July 20, 2021, 7:30 PM, 3003 N. Snelling, Roseville, Totino Fine Arts Center F2106 Carousel

Both evolutionary and biblical models of the origin of viruses are presented, followed by a brief survey of viral types and their interaction with human cells. Beneficial uses of viruses in medical treatment and a few selected viral diseases are discussed. This talk ends with some comments on the current Covid-19 situation and a novel approach to vaccination. This topic should be of special interest to many.

Have you considered...

... the yellow penguin? Recently a wildlife photographer took a picture of a yellow King penguin on South Georgia Island, near Antarctica. King penguins usually sport a tuxedo look with white front and black back, sides, head, and feet with traces of yellow around their neck. This yellow penguin has no black. Without a deep DNA study, biologists think that a mutation, caused this pronounced yellow look, when not enough black melanin was produced. This was a loss of information, not evolution. A melanin shortage may be harmful. 1. Less melanin means less UV protection. 2. Less melanin means weaker feathers. Melanin gives more structural strength to a feather. 3. Less melanin results in less camouflage. The top half of the penguin as viewed when swimming is black from above, blending in with the dark waters below it. The underside is light, so when seen from below, it blends in with the sunlit water above. The yellow penguin doesn't have the camouflage he needs. Prey such as leopard seals will notice this penguin easily.

The yellow penguin has a loss of information mutation. This testifies to Genesis 3, when sin and death entered into the world causing decay and the second law of thermodynamics. A yellow penguin attests to Scripture being true, not evolution, everything is running down.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF
