Myth and Mystery of the Minnesota Glaciers

Tuesday September 21, 2021, 7:30 PM, 3003 N. Snelling, Roseville, Totino Fine Arts Center F2106 Was Minnesota really cut gouged and bulldozed by glaciers? Is there scientific evidence for this? Have you considered...

...ancient Egyptians with memory of Noah? Scripture teaches us that eight people were saved from the worldwide Flood aboard the Ark: Noah, his wife, 3 sons and their wives. Eight total. Egyptologists have discovered in Egypt's oldest inscriptions, the Pyramid Texts, eight gods call the Ogdoad. Four males and their wives. The chief god is Nu and his wife is Nu.t. They were worshiped at a temple (now gone) at El Ashmunein-"Eight City" in Coptic (Hermopolis-Greek) (Khemenu). The Egyptian Pyramid Text shows Nu standing in the waters of chaos, holding up a barque (type of boat) of the sun with seven other deities. The Book of the Dead records the reason for this Flood, "They have done evil, they have formed rebellions, they have caused slaughter...yet, you (Nu) shall not see evil, you shall not suffer. Their years are limited, their months are closing in... and I shall indeed destroy all I made, and this land shall turn into Nun, as a floodwater, as in original condition."

How did this information get to Egypt? Noah had three sons, one named Ham. Ham had four sons, one named Mizraim. Mizraim is the Hebrew name for Egypt in the Old Testament. In the Psalms, Egypt is called the "land of Ham". Ham's family settled in this region after the tower of Babel, taking the memory of Noah and the flood. Based on Genesis 9:20-27, Ham's family slipped into apostasy. The Flood account became corrupt yet, we still find echoes of Genesis in Egyptian history.


