Have you considered...

...Autumn leaves? As summer comes to an end, the deciduous trees start preparing for winter. The key factor for starting this process is the decrease in the amount of sunlight. (A second factor is the cool weather). As the sunlight decreases, the abscission layer starts forming between the stem and the branch. The flow of water to the leaf and the flow of sugar out of the leaf begin to stop. Chlorophyll, which causes the leaves to be green, fades away which causes the hidden colors to show- orange or yellow. The red leaves are formed by the extra sugar that the leaf makes and cannot get out (due to the abscission layer). God could have made all deciduous trees turn from green leaves to brown leaves; there is no purpose for the reds, yellows or oranges, other than beauty. Why did He not make the tree leaves just wither away into drabness? God is a God who loves beauty; maybe God made autumn leaves beautiful just for the shear joy it. As you look at this autumn's cacophony of colors –the reds, yellows and oranges - enjoy the beauty that God created.

We are starting to gain some attendance at our meetings each month but are still less than 50. Our meeting room seats about 200 so there are plenty of seats where you can spread out as much as you like. This month Dave and Mary Jo Nutting plan to be with us in person. They are always interesting and this will be a great time to see friends you haven't seen for many months.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF






