Have you considered...

...stromatolites? They help us understand how the pre-Flood world was watered. These ubiquitous fossils of precipitated sediments in mats from blue-green algae are found worldwide. Living stromatolites were thought to only exist in Shark's Bay Australia but they have since been found in an upland bog and lowlands in unusual water chemistry and surface springs. Scientists decided to plot the location of fossil stromatolites on the pre-Flood world. The result, they were found to be in highlands, lowlands and shallow seas, the same areas as today. The abundance of stromatolite fossils confirmed that the pre-Flood world had many springs. Genesis 2 speaks of how "a mist went up from the earth and watered the whole face of the ground". The abundance of these fossils on every continent and in every type of environment shows us the world had abundant springs which would have watered the pre-Flood world. Who would have thought that fossil stromatolites confirm the pre-Flood watering system as written in Genesis! God's word is always true!

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths. We believe that the origin of matter and all basic types of living things, including man, came about through direct creative acts of God during the six-day creation week described in Genesis. Whatever biological changes have occurred since the creation week have accomplished only changes within the created kinds. We believe that the great flood described in Genesis, commonly referred to as the Noachian Flood, was an historic event, world-wide in extent and effect. We accept the account of the special creation of Adam and Eve as the first man and woman. Their subsequent fall into sin, by disobedience of God's direct command, is the basis for our belief in the necessity of a Savior for all mankind. Therefore, we believe that Jesus Christ is our Lord and only Savior and that personal faith in Him is necessary for salvation.

The Twin Cities Creation Science Association was founded in 1973 and has been meeting monthly for almost of 49 years. We don't meet in December and for many years skipped August too. The cartoons are by Dan Lietha who lived in Brooklyn Park until he went to work for Answers in Genesis several years ago. Dan Nuckols also contributed several cartoons to our newsletter over the years, he is now producing Christian movies.

Julie Von Vett home-schooled her two kids and coordinated a science fair for several years, she now teaches science to home-school coops all over the metro and beyond. Julie also writes the 'Have You Considered' articles in this newsletter. That start connected her to Bruce Malone's ministry 'Search for the Truth' and now she has coauthored 3 devotional books. Those books should be in every Christian home, they can be lifechanging by reading just one page a day for a year. They are now changing lives in several countries.

Prior to Covid we averaged a bit over 100 people attending our meetings each month, we are increasing our average and the past few months we are in the 70s on average and climbing.
