Flat Earth: False Education

Flat earth, false education: Today many Christians and non-Christians alike are buying into the idea of a flat earth. In fact, more people believe this now more than in any time of history. Where is this coming from? Is there any merit to it? We will examine some of the arguments that are out there and see why this false teaching has risen in recent years as well as to try and unite believers on the truth of this topic without passing judgment.

Have you considered...

...Sonar? Sonar is Sound Navigation and Ranging. The Navy did not create it on its own but copied the bat. The bat uses sonar or echolocation to find its lunch. The bat sends out a high pitch ultrasound click, 10 times per second. The click hits an object and echoes back. The echo is picked up by the ears which send the signals to the brain to be interpreted and a mental picture is formed. When the bat produces the high-pitched sound wouldn't it go deaf? Tiny muscles close the ear when the click is made and then opens to receive the returning click. When a bat is in the search mode it will send clicks at 10 per second sweeping the area. If the echo returns identifying an insect such as a mosquito, it locks onto the mosquito and increased the clicks to 100 per second in the attack mode. Can any insects pick up these ultrasonic clicks? Yes, some can, the hawk moth is one. It has two types of cells on its body, A1 and A2. When a bat sends out its sweeping search clicks and it strikes the A1 cell, the impulses are sent to the brain, "better get out of here" and the hawk moth flies in the opposite direction. When the bat hears the echo from the hawk moth, the bat locks onto the object and increases the clicks to the attack mode. These clicks strike the A2 cell sending a signal to "Do something NOW or you will be lunch!" The hawk moth either drops to the ground or spirals, both maneuvers help it evade being eaten.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths. We believe that the origin of matter and all basic types of living things, including man, came about through direct creative acts of God during the six-day creation week described in Genesis. Whatever biological changes have occurred since the creation week have accomplished only changes within the created kinds. We believe that the great flood described in Genesis, commonly referred to as the Noachian Flood, was an historic event, world-wide in extent and effect. We accept the account of the special creation of Adam and Eve as the first man and woman. Their subsequent fall into sin, by disobedience of God's direct command, is the basis for our belief in the necessity of a Savior for all mankind. Therefore, we believe that Jesus Christ is our Lord and only Savior and that personal faith in Him is necessary for salvation.

A little history of TCCSA. TCCSA was started in 1973 but the first actual newsletter that we have in our archives is from April 1976. It states TCCSA is a Branch Chapter of the Bible-Science Assn. of Caldwell, ID. Which was started by Walter Lang who later moved it to the Twin Cities and is now called Creation Moments.

Activities of the TCCSA are 1. "Sponsor meetings with Well-informed speakers discuss data from scientific disciplines which touch on Creationism." 2. "Sponsor Assistance and Special events in schools, churches or homes for an hour, a day(s), an evening(s), or for a week-end, utilizing creationist literature, tapes, films, tours, et cetera." 3. "Give assistance to individuals or groups in the source and choice of Creationist literature, speakers, visual aids, et cetera."

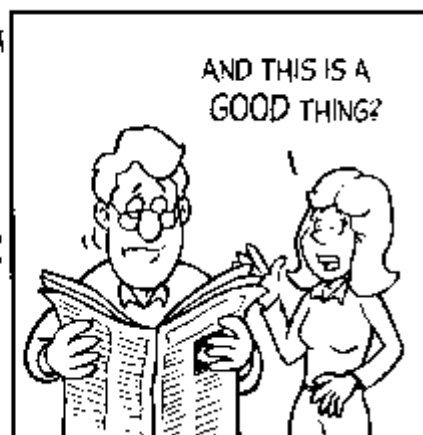
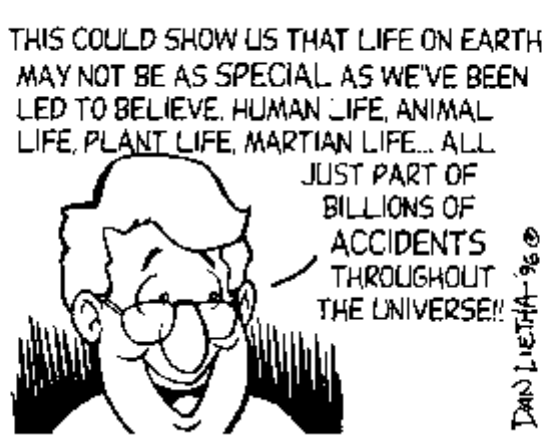
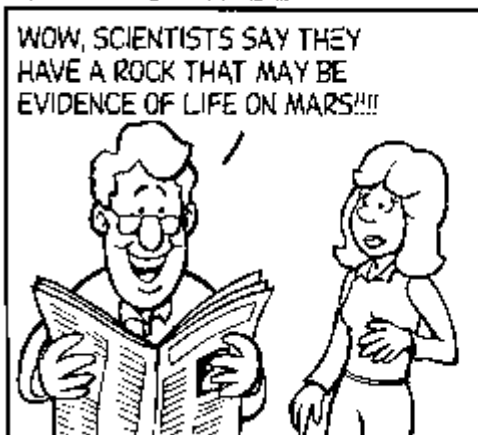
