Distant Starlight & Biblical Creation

Tuesday August 15, 2023, 7:30 PM, Univ. of Northwestern, Totino Fine Arts Center, Room F2106

We see stars and galaxies that are so far away, it seems their light would need millions or even billions of years for the light to reach us. Many people have used this to challenge the idea that the heavens and Earth were created merely thousands of years ago. This talk shows how this seemingly straightforward challenge relies on multiple assumptions being true--and at least some of them are false. Furthermore, it is not Biblical Creation which is disproved by distant starlight. It turns out that the Big Bang model has a fatal 'light travel time' problem of its own. The vastness of the cosmos does not disprove the Bible--instead, it supports the glory of our Creator.

Have you considered...

...Carp? Crucian carp in Northern European ponds with no predator fish in the pond are standard size. Once a predator fish was introduced to the ponds and eats a carp, the other carp grew large humps on their backs which prevented the predator fish from swallowing them. How was this happening? Were the carp involved in natural selection? NO. Researchers discovered a new paradigm: creatures were making logical adjustments to their environment. The new paradigm involved 1. Sensors 2. Analysis 3. Targeted response. This is called continuous environmental tracking (CET).

So, back at the pond. Crucian carp were swimming in a predator free pond, the carp's bodies were shallow shaped. One of the carp buddies we will call "Bob". One day the carp asked, "Has anyone seen Bob lately?" (A northern pike was introduced to the pond and had just eaten Bob, now the pike was going to the bathroom.) "Wait a minute", said one of the carp, "I smell Bob". The other carp also picked up the chemical scent. Immediately, the carp bodies began to change, a huge hump grew on their backs, now the northern pike would not be able to swallow them. The carp had sensors to read their environment and adjusted accordingly. This is the opposite of natural selection. This new paradigm shift finds creatures adapting to their environment because of built in sensors, logical analysis, and targeted responses. The carp did not change their body shape if predator fish were present, it only changed when a carp had been eaten and the "Bob" smell permeated the pond. Scientists are discovering that crucian carp are well engineered to respond to their environment with preprogrammed sensors, logical analysis, and a targeted response. In Genesis 1:22,26,28, God commanded, "Be fruitful, multiply, and fill the earth." And that is what creatures are doing by continually tracking their environment.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

More History


