Location of Mount Sinai

Tuesday March 19, 2024, 7:00 PM, Univ. of Northwestern, Totino Fine Arts Center, Room F2106 Do you know that over two dozen sites have been proposed for the true location of Mount Sinai? What assumptions lay behind these different proposals, and what Biblical criteria can help us assess the various candidates? This session summarizes the main points of the popular Patterns of Evidence film series on Mount Sinai, as well as brings new thoughts into consideration. See how standard paradigms and different approaches to interpreting the Bible affect the arguments made in this debate. Can a closer look at the Biblical account help determine the best choice, as well as show why the location of Mount Sinai is important in the first place?

Steve Law is a lead researcher for the Patterns of Evidence film series by Thinking Man Films. See and hear the evidence they found regarding the location of Mr. Sinai. There are more than 20 sites claiming to be Mount Sinai. What does the evidence say? This should be interesting to anyone who reads the Bible. We will get a look at the Exodus in a new light.

Have you considered ...

... that Genesis 5 tells the gospel story. What may appear as the most boring part of the Bible in reality fascinating. In Genesis 5 is found the genealogy of the pre-flood people... When Adam had lived 130 years, he became the father of a son and named him Seth... Seth became the father of Enosh... And Enosh lived 90 years, and became the father of Kenan... and so on (Jesus was born of this genealogical lineage). Back in those days, names had meanings and when naming a child, the parent was very aware of that meaning. The following are the names of the antediluvian patriarchs and there meanings.

Adam means, "man", Seth means "appointed", Enosh means "mortal", Kenan means "sorrow", Mahalelel means "The Blessed God", Jared means "Shall come down", Enoch means "teaching", Methuselah means 'His death shall bring", Lamech means despairing", Noah means "comfort or rest". When we hook all the meanings together we read, "Man is appointed mortal sorrow, but the blessed God shall come down, teaching his death, shall bring the despairing comfort and rest." Here in Genesis, we find the prophetic message of Jesus Christ!



TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths. 
