The Genesis story hidden within the ancient Chinese written symbols
Since the original religion of the ancient Chinese is similar to that of the ancient Hebrews, as described in the Bible, it should not be surprising to discover that the inventor(s) of the ancient Chinese writing system knew and believed in an identical account of creation and earth's beginnings as found in the book of Genesis in the Hebrew Bible. The oldest extant forms of the Chinese written characters have been preserved on bronze vessels and tortoise shells or scapula bones from sheep and bulls. For example the Chinese character meaning 'boat' is composed of three parts (radicals):

舟 八 口 船

Vessel + eight + people/mouths = boat

Research has demonstrated that the original God of China was called 'Heaven' or 'ShangDi' and the ancient Chinese people, including Confucius, worshiped Him.
