Greetings to you our friends and supporters.

Just a quick update on our mission to China. As we reported in our July prayer letter, mainland China is closed at this time for our mission trip that we had hoped to go on in October.

God is opening a door to a Chinese church in Taiwan. It is in the second largest city on the south end of the island, Kaohsiung City. The missionary pastor there is excited to have us come and teach a creation science dinosaur and the Bible vacation Bible school (VBS) in February 2020. He and the church leaders had been thinking about doing a science camp for quite a while and feel we are an answer to their prayers.



Partly because of the trade wars with China and Amy going with me we need to raise \$2000 more to go on this mission trip. When I first raised money for the China mission, we were not married yet and I did not include her in the budget. We appreciate those who gave two and a half years ago and that money is still in our Great Wall of China Mission fund. We just need to add to it now. If you could help with \$25, \$50 or \$100 that would be a big blessing.

I should add that things went well in Minnesota. I just returned from teaching there for 12 days. Thank you for your prayers for that trip.
