The Exodus Giants: The Archaeological Evidence

7:30 PM, June 20, 2006, Totino Fine Arts Center Room 116, Northwestern College

Do you recall the report given by the twelve spies of "the land flowing with milk and honey"? How they compared themselves to grasshoppers in the sight of the giants? This month the giants mentioned in Exodus will have their chance to speak to us from ancient Egyptian texts. Dr. Billington will compare these texts with Old Testament references to the Anakim giants in the land of Canaan. Goliath was an Anakim giant who joined the Philistines and was killed by David. References to Goliath will be covered in Scripture and a possible reference found in the ancient city of Gath.

Dr. Clyde Billington, Professor of Bible History at Northwestern College described the excavations of Jericho and told us about Sennacherib's battles in previous visits to TCCSA. He shows how archaeological digs confirm the truth found in the Bible.

If you have heard Dr. Billington you know the treat waiting for you. He is able to make dead things come alive for young and old alike. You won't be sorry you came and brought your family and friends.

All meetings are free and open to the public. A free-will offering will be accepted.



TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths.
