Dragons, Myth or History?

Dragon stories are ubiquitous; nearly every ancient culture has one. Many ancient historians, including Herodotus and Josephus, report on dragons. Alexander the Great and Marco Polo reported seeing dragons. Cities around the world maintain monuments, sculptures and paintings of dragons. Ancient books, including the Bible and the Epic of Gilgamesh mention dragons. Dictionaries up to about 100 years ago, define dragons as a living creature.

Are dragons a myth? Or are they legendary? This talk endeavors to explore what we know about dragons from both history and other writings. Neil Smith is a TCCSA board member with an extensive background in looking for evidence to support investigations.

Have you considered...

...stick insects? These insects are virtually found world wide. They are the masters of disguise, with most looking like sticks. Yet there are stick insects looking like leaves, bark, moss, or lichen, all this so they blend into their surroundings. Even their eggs are camouflaged; they look like seeds. The stick insects found in New Mexico glue their eggs on grass. These eggs resemble the very seeds of that species of grass they feed upon, having the same shape and position. Stick insects do not just look like a stick; they act like one too, when moving they act like they are swaying in the wind. These leaf eaters are nocturnal.

Evolution says they evolved this way over time. Well wouldn't they have been eaten if they looked like half a stick? If they were not eaten, then why evolve to look like a stick? When we see such disguises we know there must be a disguise maker. Disguises do not happen by accident and chance. God knew what these stick insects would experience after the Fall, sin with its curse, and so gave these insects superb disguises.

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
