### Have you considered ...

...blue eyes? Most people in the world have brown eyes; however, many people of European descent have blue eyes. Our eye color comes from the amount of melanin or pigment in our irises. Blue eyes have less melanin in the irises than brown eyes. When light hits an iris with less melanin it gets scattered, so the eye appears blue. This is like sunlight bouncing off air molecules making the sky look blue. There is NO blue pigment in the iris so where do blue eyes originate? Blue eyes are a genetic mutation resulting in less melanin in the iris. Scientists discovered that 2 genes are involved. The HERC2 gene inhibits the OCA2 gene resulting in less melanin being produced. Originally all people were brown-eyed so blue-eyed people have a loss of information. Is this mutation harmful? Less melanin means more light will go through the iris. Some blue-eyed people have light sensitivity that can be a disadvantage, thankfully we have sunglasses today.

How does this fit into the biblical perspective? Prior to the Tower of Babel, descendants of Noah intermarried. If the mutation occurred at that time it could have been hidden, for brown eye genes are dominate over blue eye genes. After the Tower of Babel small groups scattered limiting their gene pool, blue-eyes could become more common. We find most blue-eyed people are of European descent. Those with blue eyes have lost information on their genetic code. All blue-eyed people have this mutation passed on from a common ancestor. 
