...From the black plague burial pits of Europe, scientists have found what helped individuals to survive the Bubonic plague. The Black Death or Bubonic plague killed up to half the population of Europe during the mid-1300s. It seems that if a person had the mutated gene ERAP2, they were "40% likely to survive the plague". This mutated gene was passed on to future generations.

You may say, look a helpful mutation! But there is a downside, this plague-resisting gene is linked to auto-immune diseases such as Crohn's disease. Auto-immune diseases attack one's own body causing serious health problems. Evolution teaches that mutations were involved from one cell evolving into a person. Yet, science has found that 99% of mutations are NOT beneficial. Yes, those with this mutated gene survived the Black Death but now deal with auto-immune diseases. TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. 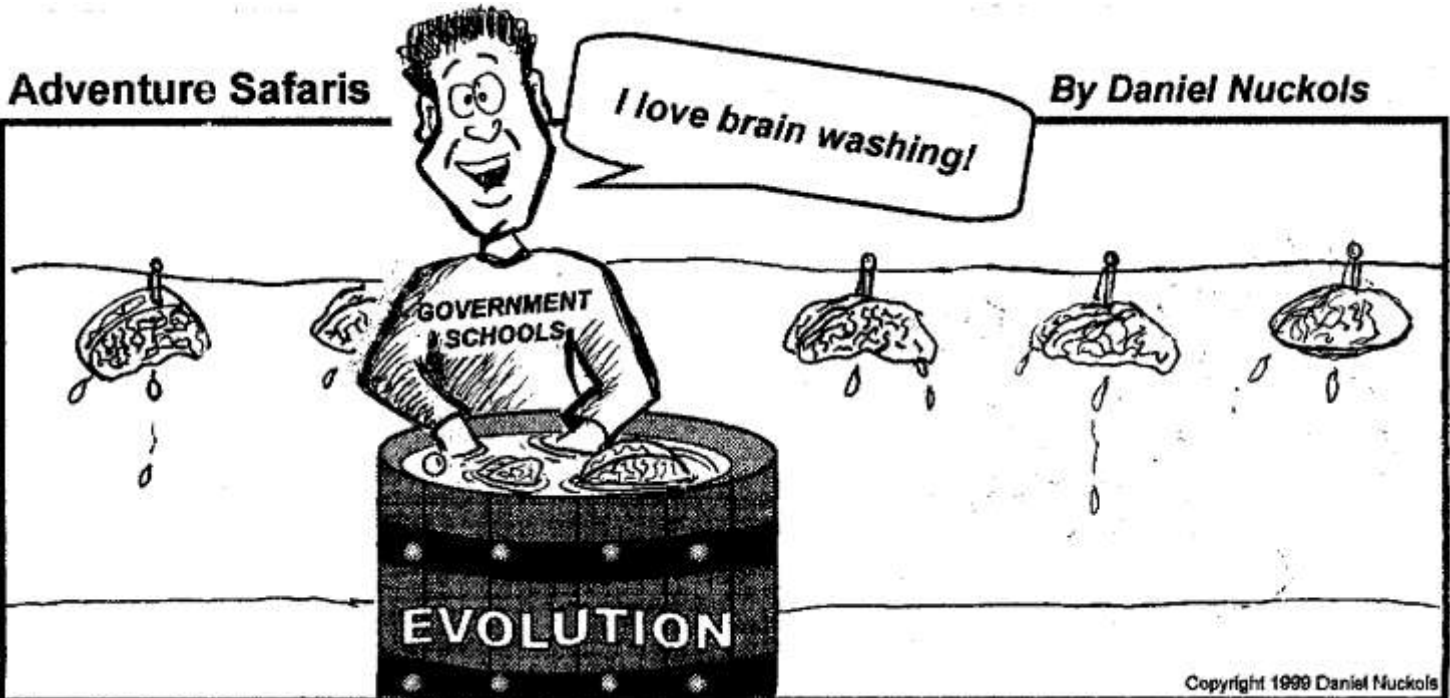
A bit of TCCSA history

TCCSA was started in 1973 but we have almost no information from the first 3 years. The first document regarding meetings lists the Nov. 8, 1975 meeting with Dr. Donald Chittick of Newberg, OR presenting *Creation Model Workshop for Teachers*.

The second listing on Jan. 20, 1976 was a family night with the Moody Science Films *Living Waters* and *Red River of Life*. Those Moody films are still available with excellent information and very well done.

On Feb. 17, 1976 they had a Danish-pastry Dessert Fellowship with Rev. Walter Lang narrating the filmstrip on locating Noah's Ark.

Looks like they had a variety of programs with at least some located at Northwestern College but at the old campus. In 1977 they had a couple meetings at Viking Village with a meal.
