...We could not breathe without the moon!

TCCSA's STATEMENT OF BELIEF

We believe in God: The Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We believe that the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and that all of its assertions are historically and scientifically true in the original autographs; this means that the account of origins in Genesis is a factual presentation of actual historical truths. We believe that the origin of matter and all basic types of living things, including man, came about through direct creative acts of God during the six-day creation week described in Genesis. Whatever biological changes have occurred since the creation week have accomplished only changes within the created kinds. We believe that the great flood described in Genesis, commonly referred to as the Noachian Flood, was an historic event, world-wide in extent and effect. We accept the account of the special creation of Adam and Eve as the first man and woman. Their subsequent fall into sin, by disobedience of God's direct command, is the basis for our belief in the necessity of a Savior for all mankind. Therefore, we believe that Jesus Christ is our Lord and only Savior and that personal faith in Him is necessary for salvation.

The earth's air is made up of about 21% oxygen, 78% nitrogen, 0.03% carbon dioxide, and trace amounts of other gases. Chemical reactions within plants and in our upper atmosphere maintain this exact balance of 21% oxygen to 0.03% carbon dioxide. **For life to exist, this balance must have been maintained from the beginning!** If oxygen levels were lower by only 4%, animals could not breathe. If oxygen levels were higher by as little as 4%, increased fires and extensive oxidation reactions would make life on Earth difficult-if not impossible. With even a slight change of the carbon dioxide level, the earth's temperature and plant growth rates would be radically affected.

It would seem that the very composition of the air we breathe has been designed specifically for our benefit. It takes incredible faith to believe this could have happened by chance.
