Did Man Live With Dinosaurs?

Even though many evolutionists will tell you that people and dinosaurs never lived together, and that dinosaurs went extinct a long time ago, there is a lot of proof not only that people and dinosaurs co-existed, but that there are dinosaurs alive today. Cave drawings, historical literature, and fossils all show man and dinosaurs living together. An examination of these facts will show that people and dinosaurs co-existed.

First, let us look at cave drawings. There have been many cave drawings found in places such as the Grand Canyon, in ravines, various caves, and other places. In Natural Bridges State Park, there are petroglyphs depicting dinosaur-like animals by the Anazi Indians, 400-1500 A.D. An Indian pictograph found in the Havasupai Canyon in the Grand Canyon shows men hunting dinosaurs.

People have found stones with similar, but much more detailed, motifs. These stones are found in Ica, Peru, are about the size of bowling balls, appear to be made of granite, and have a polished look. One of the stones on display at Dinosaur Adventure Land, Pensacola, Florida, clearly shows a man cutting the head off of a dinosaur. One shows a dinosaur holding a man by the head. In another, a dinosaur has a man by the head and the man's spirit is leaving. One shows detailed skin on a dinosaur. It is reasonable to assume the people who made the drawings saw the living creatures they were drawing, not just a bunch of fossilized bones.

Archaeology also indicates that people were alive with dinosaurs. There was a fossil found with a human foot print inside of a dinosaur's. The dinosaur could not have made the print, then millions of years later have a human leave his inside. There was a Roman mosaic found showing two long necked dinosaurs from the second century, A.D. and a Roman sword with a dragon on it. A Viking wood cut was found showing a dragon swallowing a man.

All this makes good argument along with the most reliable source, historical records. The Bible does not say a whole lot about dinosaurs, but in Job 41:19 God refers to an animal that many people think is a dragon. Evolutionists try to explain it away by saying it is a hippo or an elephant. This theory fits until we read the verse, "he waveth his tail like a cedar tree". A hippo's tail doesn't resemble a cedar tree. In literature, even in children's books, such as *St. George and the Dragon*, dinosaurs are talked about. Yes, they are talking about dragons, not dinosaurs, but that is because the word dinosaur wasn't used until 1841. It is the same thing, just a different name.

With fossils, Ica stones, cave drawings, and literature we see evidence that dinosaurs and man did in fact live together. It seems common sense that if man was living with a big, dangerous animal, that they would kill and or drive them off. That could be why people do not see very many of them anymore. None the less, man lived with dinosaurs.
